Vernon Township Cemeteries

The Vernon Township Cemetery is located in Lincolnshire at the corner of Old Half Day Road and Milwaukee Avenue. Grave sites and mausoleum spaces are available for purchase. The mausoleum contains 64 crypts, and 24 columbarium niches. Two

additional columbarium units were recently added to the cemetery. Each individual crypt or niche may be personalized.

The Diamond Lake Cemetery is located on Route 60(east of Route 45) in Mundelein. Only grave sites are available at this cemetery.

From the Desk of the Assessor

Assessment Notices

2015 is a General Reassessment year (formerly referred to as a Quadrennial). What this means is that every four years, by law, the Assessor must review and reassess all property in their jurisdiction. We will be looking at all the sales over the past three years and adjusting assessments as needed, per Illinois State Statutes. (35 ILCS 200/9-155) I would like to remind property owners that if they have any question about their assessments we will be more than happy to answer those questions. Our office is here to help you understand the assessment process. Assessment notices (the "Blue Letter") will appear in mail boxes later this summer.

Exemptions

If you are 65 years or older you can apply for a Senior Citizen's Exemption. Our office has applications available for you to fill out or you can go online and get one. We would need you come in with your drivers license as proof of age and a copy of your deed. If you can not locate your deed the assessor's office will be more than happy to print out a copy of the deed for you. If your property is in a trust, you must supply the article of the trust showing Lifetime Provisions indicating that you are the beneficiary of the proceeds generated by the trust, such as the sale of your home. An example of that would read: During My Lifetime all income will be distributed etc. or I retain the right to control and distribute income from my trust etc. If you have any questions about this exemption you can call our office at 847-634-4602

Chief County Assessment Office Exemption Recapture Information

New state law (effective June 1, 2014) gives the Chief County Assessment Office authority to recapture taxable value in instances where property owners have received homestead benefits erroneously. The new law aims to create a more fairly distributed property tax burden which benefits taxpayers.

Taxpayers are eligible to receive a HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION on only one property in any given year. This applies to properties outside of Lake County and even in other states. You may check your property exemption status, or report any erroneous exemptions by contacting the Vernon Township Assessor's Office at 847-634-4602. We can help you get your exemptions in order and make sure you are receiving all the exemptions you are entitled to. We urge all taxpayers to look at their tax bills every year to make sure you receive your exemptions.

Highway Department Briefs

Indian Creek/Olsen Ct. Storm Sewer Project

Vernon Township Highway Department worked in cooperation with the Village of Lincolnshire to alleviate flooding and drainage issues just north of Olsen Court on Indian Creek Road. This project consisted of installing new storm sewer along the east side of Indian Creek Road and down Olsen Court.

Due to the jurisdictional situation of the project, the two municipalities formed an agreement to complete the project together. To hire an outside contractor was considered, but would have cost well over the budgeted amount to do the project ourselves. By combining the equipment and knowledgeable manpower of the township and the village the project was completed efficiently and on a timely basis.

Passport Applications

Vernon Township has been a passport acceptance agency for 15 years. Persons wishing to apply for a passport may come to the township offices at 3050 N Main St. in Buffalo Grove. The office hours are Monday through Friday 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. No appointment is necessary, however, in the past few years the township has noticed an increase in passport applications which may lead to long wait times.

In order to process your applications quickly and efficiently applicants should remember a few key things:

First, visit the state department web site at www.travel.state.gov for the most up to date travel information. This site will inform you of travel restrictions, passport requirements, and has the most recent passport application forms. (Please note: Applications printed off sites other than the State Department may be expired.)



Second, when completing the applications, use only black ink. When printing the application off the web site, use single sheets only, double sided forms will not be accepted. Social Security numbers are required as is parent information, regardless of whether parents are living or deceased. Remember to bring your original proof of citizenship such as your certified birth certificate or naturalization paper or old passport. Photos may be brought in or taken at the township. When processing your application at the township only checks or money orders are acceptable for payment to the State Department. Agency fees to the township may be paid by check or cash. Credit/Debit Cards are not accepted by the township.

Lake County Prescription Drug Collection Boxes

Lake County Drug Free Communities program has the following sites available for prescription drug drop-off. The blue boxes (which look similar to post office mail boxes) are located in the lobby and are accessible 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Prescriptions must be in their original container, and no needles or sharp objects are allowed.

Vernon Township's Medical Lending Closet

Vernon Township's Medical Lending Closet has a variety of donated durable medical equipment items available for temporary use by our residents. Crutches, canes, bathroom items and more are available for no fee to township residents. Wheelchairs are available for a \$50 refundable deposit.

This program is becoming increasingly popular so it is suggested that you call the township for availability ahead of picking up the equipment. When picking up the equipment you will be asked to fill out a small application. There is no time limit on the use of the equipment; however, the lending closet equipment is for temporary use. We appreciate your returning the equipment as soon as you no longer need it. The lending closet is very popular and we want to be able to accommodate as many residents as possible.

The closet is open Monday-Friday from 8:30 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. for Vernon Township residents. Donations of medical equipment are accepted during the same hours.
